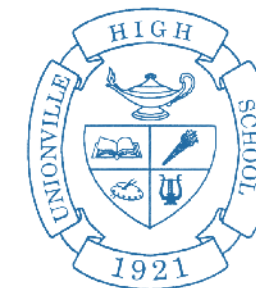

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

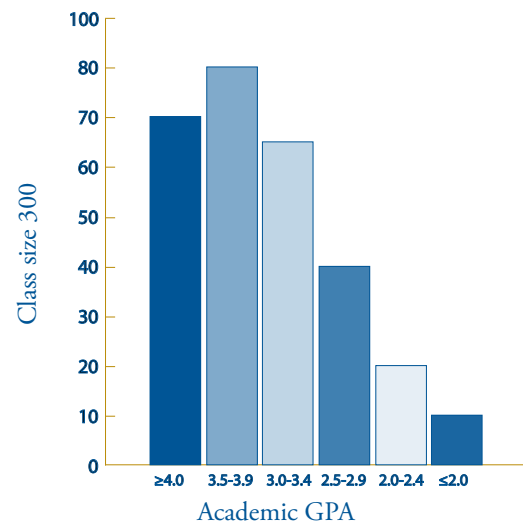
Each student must earn a minimum of 22 credits in grades 9-12 and demonstrate proficiency on the Keystone Test in Biology, Algebra, and Literature. Courses are offered on a year-long or semester basis, with grades being reported quarterly.
